



## Enterprise Energy Dashboard

The Air Force Enterprise Energy Dashboard (Dashboard) is the Air Force's tool for monitoring its performance against the Energy Strategy. The Dashboard is designed to provide common-sight views of energy metrics to all Airmen and provide access to a Library of Knowledge filled with valuable energy resources.

- **Key Performance Indicators (Scorecard)** provide senior leaders and other Dashboard users with a visual snapshot of overall progress towards achieving Air Force energy goals.



- **Metrics** are provided for the key energy functional areas within the Air Force



- **Library of Knowledge** The Library of Knowledge is designed to provide fast and up-to-date energy resources across the Air Force's energy community
