## **MORE THAN JUST FUEL**


More than just fuel, the smart use of operational energy enables more training, greater combat range, and lowers sustainment costs increasing operational agility to reinforce mission success.



## SAF/IEN EFFORT TO IMPROVE OPERATIONAL ENERGY EDUCATION & TRAINING

In partnership with the Office of the Secretary of Defense, SAF/IEN wants to enhance mission effectiveness by introducing operational energy concepts in a broad range of education and training (E&T) venues. **The intent is to incorporate operational energy awareness and best practices into E&T in a way that adds value and is not disruptive to current curricula.** To date, SAF/IEN's E&T accomplishments include:

- Developing a career Continuum of Learning (shown below) that maps representative E&T opportunities
- Socializing the importance of operational energy with key elements of the Air Force E&T enterprise
- Researching multiple energy efficient best practices for pilots, logisticians, maintainers, planners and other AFSCs that have a vested interest in optimizing operational energy.



The office is now connecting with Air Force E&T subject matter experts to better understand the curricula development process for courses they support. SAF/IEN's focus is to make sure they are developing course inputs that are relevant to attendees, integrate easily into current content, and do not put additional resource burden on course developers.
